GAUDIUM ET SPES LECTURE 2009

The Institute for Research on the Signs of the Times (DISCERN) is organising its Gaudium et Spes Lecture 2009 on Thursday 19th November at 7:00p.m. This event will be held at the Phoenicia Hotel, Floriana. This year's lecture will be addressing the question: 'Banking on Virtue?'
