SOUND SYSTEMS

- (a) AT THE GRANARIES
- (b) AT RABAT
- (c) AT THE WATERFRONT

It is essential for the success of the Pope's visit that excellent sound systems are used for each of his speeches and prayer sessions.

The Interdiocesan Committee organising the events which will take place during the Pope's visit invites separate preliminary expressions of interest for each of the following:

- The meeting with people at St Paul's Square in Rabat on the 17th April in the evening;
- The mass on the Granaries on the 18th April in the morning, including sound systems for a choir and orchestra and for a children's choir.
- The young people's celebration at the Valletta Waterfront on the 18th April in the afternoon on a setup stage (including bands, choir and orchestra, and a PA System).

Plans showing where the diases/altar area will be placed will be sent to initial expressions. Second expressions will present all technical details, methods of liaising with TV coverage, prices and time frames for the setting up and testing of all systems, the sound engineers present at the time of the activity, back-ups available and dismantling of the systems put up.

The setting up of the systems will be directed by security personnel and the dismantling

should be done as soon as possible after the event is over.

The Interdiocesan Committee cannot be held responsible for any damages or losses caused to the sound systems put up.

The supplier will be required to take out full insurance cover, as and when needed. Sponsorships are much appreciated and will be acknowledged in a very appropriate way.
