- a minimum of four (4) years' work experience in the field of journalism

- excellent oral and written communication skills (both in Maltese and English)

- excellent presentation and interviewing skills
- excellent time management skills with the ability to assign and delegate tasks
- the willingness to travel abroad and execute timely news coverage
- a clean driving licence.

The following will be considered an asset:

- particular interest in any of the following: the environment, migration, political science, international affairs, health issues and economics.

The successful applicant, who will report to the Editor-in-chief, will be responsible for ensuring high-level content creation related to news and current affairs for radio and online, with emphasis on off-diary and human stories, and investigative journalism.
